What person will be able to go up into YHWH's holy Hill (Hebrews 12:22-24) and abide in His Holy Sanctuary? Only a person whose actions are deemed innocent and clean, in the Eyes of Heaven. But, because of *Yahshua's* Life and Sacrifice, His record of sanctified living may be ours. We may be washed, and strengthened to walk in victory through the Saviour's Power – 2 Corinthians 7:1.

This verse is a special calling to all who are spiritually asleep – even more than it is a calling to those who are physically lazy. Consider Romans 13:11 and Ephesians 5:14. YHWH cries to His professing children, How long will you lay in idleness, resting when the hour is so late. We are called to work for the night is coming. Yet, so many of His professed people are laid, nearly to the point of death, with idolatry and spiritual fornication. We forget that even a little such sleep on enemy ground brings spiritual staleness, which may become incurable, delivering us into death. YHWH calls us to get up, hold on, be strengthened and abide in Him that through Him we may accomplish His Will and succeed in His Purpose. If we continue to lay about in our Laodicean stupor, we will become destitute and spiritually poor, like a wandering Prodigal who travels from place to place, never committing to serving His Father, or staying in loyalty where he can strengthen His Father’s House.

Peter walked on water, while beholding Yahshua’s Face. The Children of Israel, while beholding the serpent on the Cross (a symbol of Yahshua’s Death), were healed from the serpent’s poison and saved. By beholding, we become changed. The Bible tells us not to be afraid, when we are in trouble. We are present ourselves before the Father’s Throne, seeking His Grace, and stand fast. Our eyes are to be riveted on Yahshua, Who is the salvation of YAH. The Egyptians, representing those in the world, who are enemies of YAH, will be no more (Psalm 37:34-36). For YAH will make war against those who try to harm me. He will consume them, while I rest quietly in Him.

### Synthesis:

**Synthesis:**

To be anointed as a priest and king in the service to the Most High (Revelation 5:10) is to become a living, consecrated gift to YHWH (Romans 12:1). It means we have become (by YHWH’s Grace) a cleansed temple (1 Corinthians 3:16-17), filled with YAH’s Spirit. It means that we accept the bitter sufferings, which are promised to all priests. It means that we choose to walk in obedience to YHWH, living an upright life, by the Saviour’s Grace. It means that we recognize we will be judged by the Law, and we live in sanctified obedience to it. It means that we are humble in spirit, before the Almighty. And that we fear and reverence Him. Only when we are ready to prayerfully make this full vow and declaration to YAH, should we be anointed with this sacred oil. For it is never to come on common (unrepentant) man’s body (Ex 30:32).

### **Spiritual Significance of the Myrrh**

Myrrh symbolizes suffering, trials, tribulations, and afflictions. The church of Smyrna is known as the "Suffering Church". This makes sense when one realizes that the name "Smyrna" comes from myrrh. Suffering and persecution is something that *Yahshua* experienced. In fact we are told that suffering was such an integral of *Yahshua's* life that, "Although He was a Son, He learned obedience from the things which He suffered" (Hebrews 5:8). And just as He was given the gift of myrrh by Wise Men, so we too, who are set apart for His holy use and anointed as priests, are to receive the gift of myrrh (suffering) from the hand of the Master. It is not done to destroy us, but to teach us obedience. "Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Messiah *Yahshua* will be persecuted" (2 Timothy 3:12).

### **Spiritual Significance of the Cinnamon**

The second ingredient of the holy anointing oil was "sweet cinnamon". Sweet denotes the savour to God that is pure and holy, not that of a natural sweetener as honey, but that of cinnamon. "Cinnamon" is the Hebrew "qinnamown" meaning "to erect, cinnamon bark as in upright rolls". The sweet cinnamon speaks of the upright life, which we are enabled to live, through our Saviour's Grace and Power.

### **Spiritual Significance of Calamus**

"Calamus" is the Hebrew "qaneh" meaning "a reed (for measuring)." Law of YHWH is represented here. "And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein." (Revelation 11:1). The measuring rod, by which we are measured (judged) is the Law of YHWH, as it says in James 2:12. The Calamus is present in the anointing oil to remind us to live in obedience to the Holy Law, by Yah's Grace.

### **Spiritual Significance of Cassia**

Cassia in Hebrews is qiddah, meaning shriveled rolls. It is from the root word which means to bend the body or neck in deference, or to bow down. Cassia signifies humility and reverence for the Most High. As it says in Job 28:28 and Psalm 111:10, fearing YHWH is the beginning of wisdom. Also in 2 Chronicles 34:27, we see that humbling ourselves before YHWH is a vital part of prayer. Our prayers are only acceptable when presented with a humble and contrite spirit.

### **Spiritual Significance of Olive Oil**

Olive oil is from the Hebrew word *zayith*, meaning "illuminating oil." It represents the presence of the Holy Spirit in the life. This is the fifth ingredient in anointing oil. We are only able to be set apart for holy use, serving as Heavenly priests, when we have the indwelling Presence of YAH's Spirit.
