The Significance of the Two Silver Trumpets

Leviticus 23:24-25 – Blow trumpets on the Feast of Trumpets

Numbers 10:2-10 “Make thee two trumpets of silver; of a whole piece shalt thou make them: that thou mayest use them for the **calling of the assembly**, and for the **journeying** of the camps. And when they shall blow with them, all the assembly shall assemble themselves to thee at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation... When ye blow an **alarm**, then the camps... shall go forward... They shall blow an alarm for their journeys. But when the congregation is to be gathered together, ye shall blow, but ye shall not sound an alarm. And the sons of Aaron, the priests, shall blow with the trumpets; and they shall be to you for an **ordinance** for ever throughout your generations. And if ye go to **war** in your land against the **enemy** that oppresseth you, then ye shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and ye shall be **remembered** before (YHWH) your God, and ye shall be **saved** from your enemies. Also in the day of your gladness, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, ye shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial before your God: I Am (YHWH) your God.”
