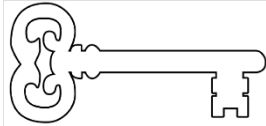

1) The Fourth Key to Unlock Bible Prophecy



Mazzaroth (Heavenly Lights) - Genesis 1:14

In the Book of Job, the heavenly lights including the stars, constellations and anciently recognized parts of our solar system, were called the Mazzaroth (constellations) (Job 38:32).

There are five reasons why Yahweh created the heavenly lights, which are listed in Genesis 1:14. All five of these reasons are related to TIME.

What are the five reasons the heavenly lights (*Mazzaroth*) were created?

- The heavenly lights define a DAY (divide the day from night)
- The heavenly lights are for "signs" (prophetic signs) - this means that the Mazzaroth is a vital part of understanding End-time Prophecy (signs) prophetic time
- The heavenly lights determine the time of "seasons" (mo'edim) - which is the Feast Days
- For Days -
- For years - the heavenly lights determine the length of the year.
Key note: the heavens are used for ALL aspects of TIME: literal, spiritual, prophetic

When Jacob was dying, he gave an END Time prophetic word over each of the 12 tribes of Israel- Genesis 49:1.

Ultimately, the Father's Work is known as the Plan of Redemption. Thus, the End-time events are connected with the Father's Work in the Last Days.

Each End-time prophecy which Jacob spoke over his sons (the 12 tribes of Israel), was manifested in the tribal ensign (symbol), banner, which appeared on the flags or standards for each tribe.

Additionally, these representations also appear in the 12 primary constellations


To begin decoding the fourth key to understanding End-time Bible Prophecy (which is the *Mazzaroth*), we need to discover which constellation is associated with each tribe of Israel.

A useful reference for understanding this key more deeply is the book ***God's Amazing Star Secret***, by Shauna Manfredine. Please know that there is far more information on the *Mazzaroth* in this book than we can possibly cover in class. 


Let's start with the overview of the tribes and their constellations, which we will represent in table form:
