Session 1: "Five Keys that Unlock Bible Prophecy"

- Bible prophecy is often misunderstood and/or misapplied, even by believers. The following are two examples of Bible prophecies which were misunderstood and misapplied in Messiah's day:
 - John the Baptist Expecting a literal fulfillment (literally Elijah) when it was a spiritual application.
 It was a misunderstanding of Malachi's prophecy. There are three
 fulfillments of any prophecy: 1) Elijah himself was the forerunner for one
 greater (Elisha) 2) John the Baptist (spiritual) 3) its often literal... more often
 - The Role of Messiah The Jews missapplied Second Coming Judgement prophecies with His
 first advent.
- 2) There are four main reasons that prophecy is misunderstood and/or misapplied:
 - Failing to <u>USE</u> the <u>FIVE KEYS</u>
 - Prophecy is <u>TIME</u> sensitive Daniel 12:9
 - Falling prey to convenient MATH
 - Relying on EXTRA BIBLICAL interpreters 1

3) Why is Bible Prophecy so difficult to interpret? It wasn't meant for people be access the "gold" of understanding, unless we are part of Yahweh's Kingdom.

If we are in the "light" we will understand - if we are in darkness, we won't.
