


Session 16: "The Original Solar System and Recent Heavenly Signs"

• The Fourth Key to Unlock Bible Prophecy



In the Book of Job, the heavenly lights including the stars, constellations and anciently recognized parts of our solar system, were called the Mazzaroth (Job 38:32).

Our Solar System is defined as the Sun and the objects that orbit it, including planets, moons, asteroids, comets and meteoroids. Our Solar System is pretty spread out over a large area of space. Scientists estimate that the edge of the solar system is about 9 billion miles (15 billion kilometers) from the sun. But this is not how our solar system was identified in the ancient world. Anciently, our Solar System contained seven heavenly bodies, as only seven things could be seen with the naked eye. This is what was given by Divine inspiration to mankind and carries prophetic meaning and spiritual significance.

As Robert Stieglitz explains in his book, *The Hebrew Names of the Seven Planets*, the ancient world considered our Solar System to be made up of seven heavenly bodies. The seven "planets" which comprised the ancient solar system were identified in the Babylonian Talmud (Shabbat 156a) and were also listed by Epiphanius, the Bishop of Constantia from 367-402 AD. Epiphanius (see picture on the following page) was born to Jewish parents and was a multi-lingual, ancient historian. His transcriptions of the Hebrew names for the planets and stars are the earliest recorded and the most accurate.

From these sources, the seven ancient heavenly bodies in our solar system (five of which are now classified as planets) are as follows:

First of the 7 Ancient Heavenly Bodies:

In Biblical times, God's people knew that the moon represented a <u>woman</u>. This is plainly seen in Jacob's interpretation of Joseph's dream (Genesis 37:1-10).

In Scripture, the saved people of God (His true Church) are represented in symbolic form. Two of the biblical symbols for the Church are: <u>The Woman (the Bride)</u> and <u>The Moon (the one who is clothed in white)</u>

Scripturally, we can find the spiritual symbol of a <u>woman</u> when we see that the true <u>Church</u>, is known as the <u>Bride</u> of <u>Messiah</u> (Ephesians 5:23-32).

Like the <u>Moon</u>, we are not the source of our own <u>Light</u>, but we reflect the "light" and "glory" of the <u>Sun (Yah)</u> (a symbol of the Bridegroom) (Ezekiel 16:14).

Additionally, the Bride is clothed in white (His Righteousness) (which is the meaning of the Hebrew word for the Moon *"Lavanah"*), representing the righteousness of Christ (Revelation 3:5 & 18). In poetic representation of Christ and His Bride, Song of Solomon compares the Bride with the Moon - Song of Solomon 6:4, 9-10.

The remaining four heavenly bodies which were anciently recognized as part of our Solar System were, as follows:

## Third of the 7 Ancient Heavenly Bodies: Venus


Ancient Hebrew Name:

One of the many meanings of the Menorah is the original 7-part solar system:



 KEY POINT: In a heavenly sky event – a prophetic sign – one or more of the

 original (Menorah)
 seven members of the
 Solar
 system

 will be interacting over the backdrop of the
 original (Biblical)
 constellations.

The meaning of the sky event is "read" or understood by determining the meaning/message of the <u>constellation</u> in which the sky event appears and by also determining the meaning / message of the <u>planet/s.s.</u> (7 original members of the <u>solar</u> <u>system</u>) which participate in the sky event.

Mankind is familiar with the concept the rhythm and interval can be used to spell words. After all, consider Morse Code.




Since 2014, Yahweh has been resounding three powerful messages – some have even been given in Morse-Code style – spelling out Hebrew words in numeric intervals.

In Hebrew, letters have numerical value. And numerical value is also to be understood to have great spiritual meaning, which goes with the meaning of the Hebrew letters. Nothing about Yahweh is by accident.

For example, the seventh Day is the Sabbath – Seven is the number which means "completion, wholeness, blessing and Res<u>t."</u>

15 = 15 in Hebrew is made by putting the Yod (10) before the Heh (5). It is the sacred Name: Yah in Hebrew.

So the number and message of 15 is proclaimed 4x – pronouncing the Name of Yah from the Heavens, calling us to honor Him.

177 = 177 in Hebrew is made by writing Qof (100), Zayin (7), Zayin (7). Qof is a call to holiness and means there

is non as holy as Yah. Zayin is the number of Sabbath and Spiritual Warfare and is doubled to signify the Call of 3rd Angel - Revelation.

162 = 162 in Hebrew is made by writing Qof (100), Vav (6), Bet (2). Six is the number of man and two is the number of Yahshua – Yah manifested, or Tabernacling, in the flesh. It is a call unto man to be holy! We should experience the indwelling Presence of Yah in our lives now – that we will be prepared to Tabernacle with Him in Person – soon.
