Global Flood (Noah) – Genesis 7:11 – Second Passover
 In Noah's 600th year, in the second month, on the 17th day of the month is when the rain began to fall for the Flood.

Genesis 1:14 tells us that the heavenly lights are used to determine what things (pertaining to time)?:


- Length of a Day they define a day
- The heavenly lights determine the (Biblical) year (when it starts, when it ends)
- Signs prophetic time
- Seasons Feasts (H4150) determine the timing of the annual holy Days.

How do the heavens determine the start of the Biblical month and year? Psalm 104:19; Leviticus 23:4; Exodus 12:2 The moon gives the timing for the annual Feasts.

The moon determines the time for the annual feasts and (Biblical) year.

The first new moon of the year is the start of the Biblical year.

The Biblical year ends on the Spring *Tekufah* (2 Samuel 11:1, Genesis 1:14). What are the four *Tekufoh* (plural of *Tekufah*)? Complete the diagram showing the four *Tekufoh*:



The Biblical year begins on the first new moon following the Spring Tekufah.

The Biblical year ends on the Spring *Tekufah*. How do we start the Biblical year – Exodus 12:2? The first month is following the Spring Tekufah

Look up "month" in E-sword. What is the Hebrew word? khodesh

Strong's #: H2320 Meaning of the word "new moon" by implication "month"

What is the Root word of this Hebrew word? khawdash (H2318)

which means: "renewed, rebuilt, repaired" - (first crescent sliver of the moon after the conjuction)

With this understanding of the primary Hebrew meaning of "month", explain how to determine the time of Passover, each year, by using the moon – Leviticus 23:5-8. Counting from the first new moon following the spring Tekufah, Passover is the 14th day. The Feast of Unleavened Bread immediately follows Passover, beginning on the 15th day and continuing for 7 days (ends on the 21st day of the first month).
